## NEWSLETTER

Dear Members:

Just a short newsletter to bring you up to date with the NRC's general status at the end of the 2006 season. The Executive held a meeting on Nov. 18 to review its financial position and to make arrangements for the 2007 season.

Financial:

We currently have about \$9,000 in hand with a few expenses related to boat and engine repair and maintenance that will have to be incurred before next season. There is also a liability to the City of Nelson related to a \$500 per year fee for the foreshore licence fee levied by the Province and normally paid by the City. This liability is at least \$1,000 and may be as much as \$3,000. Copies of an interim financial report to Nov. 2006 are attached to the email sending out this newsletter.

Junior Program:

This was reviewed with regard to what can be offered in the future. Kim Shea and Kate Plant will decide over the next 6 weeks what they are prepared to offer in the way of junior coaching next spring. This will be communicated to the Juniors' parents early in 2007.

The request by some parents for financial assistance from the NRC was considered. Due to both the club's financial position and the common practise of similar clubs for parents to fund the cost of out-of-town club activities, the request was turned down.
